

[2] A review hearing was scheduled to take place today, 10 September 2025. On 9 September 2025, counsel filed a joint memorandum.

[3] The respondents state that they do not oppose the continuation of the freezing orders. They also consent to the making of ancillary orders requiring them to provide monthly bank statements for all frozen accounts from 1 May 2025 until the orders are discharged.

[4] Counsel have been in discussion about some outstanding matters including:

- (a) the provision of the bank statements for BL69 Ltd for the period 27 June to 3 July 2025;
- (b) the provision of bank statements for the unfrozen account set up in the respondents' names for the purposes of receiving income and paying ordinary living expenses; and
- (c) the release of funds for legal fees.

[5] However, the parties agreed that today's review hearing could be vacated and appearances excused, and that a further review hearing could be scheduled for 9 October 2025.

Outcome

[6] The current freezing and ancillary orders will continue until 4 pm on Friday, 10 October 2025.

[7] A review hearing will be held, if necessary, at 2.15 pm on Thursday, 9 October 2025. The following timetable applies for that hearing:

- (a) The applicant is to file a memorandum and any other relevant documents by 4 pm on Friday, 3 October 2025.
- (b) The respondents are to file a memorandum and any other relevant documents by 4 pm on Tuesday 7 October 2025.

[8] This judgment and the orders which I now make are to be served immediately on the relevant banks.
