JUDGMENT (NO 5) OF JUDGE K G SMITH

[1] On 11 August 2025, without notice freezing and ancillary orders were granted together with further orders providing for non-publication of the judgment and that the Court file not be searched without a Judge first granting permission to do so.¹

[2] Those orders have been extended since then, most recently on 24 October 2025.² All of the orders are scheduled for review today.

[3] When the orders were extended in October 2025, the judgment recorded an agreed process whereby Mrs Khan would place \$330,000 with the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment to be held in an interest-bearing account on condition that it would be released only in accordance with a determination of the Employment Relations Authority.

[4] Today the parties have confirmed that the funds referred to in the October judgment have been paid. Because that agreement is in place they have requested jointly:

- (a) That all freezing and ancillary orders be discharged.
- (b) By consent the Court records that the respondents are jointly and severally liable to the applicant for legal costs of \$8,746.91 and disbursements of \$1,171.59.
- (c) The orders prohibiting publication and searching the Court file are not to be further extended.

[5] I accept this course of action is appropriate and orders are made accordingly.
