CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

[1] The application for interim orders was to be called before the Authority on 27 April 2009. The parties have advised the Authority they have reached a compromise between them such that a formal determination in relation to the interim orders sought is no longer required. The compromise is set out in a draft consent orders document (the "consent orders")

[2] By a joint memorandum of counsel, the parties have requested the Authority make the consent orders in respect of the compromise reached.

[3] The consent orders relate only to the application for interim orders.

[4] By consent, the terms set out in the draft consent orders document shall become the orders of the Authority.

[6] The parties have agreed that the terms of the draft consent orders remain confidential. For the purposes of preserving confidentiality, I make a further order, pursuant to clause 10 of the Second Schedule of the *Employment Relations Act 2000*, prohibiting the publication of the contents of draft consent orders document, and the names of the parties.

[7] If costs are sought they are reserved.

[8] Counsel are to liaise with the support officer to set a time for a telephone conference so that the substantive matter can be scheduled for investigation.
