DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

[1] During the course of my investigation meeting the parties advised me that they had agreed and signed terms of settlement regarding all matters between them. They have asked that I record that settlement by way of a consent order.

[2] The parties have agreed that the terms of settlement are in full, final and binding settlement of all outstanding employment related matters between them. They have also agreed that the terms of settlement should be confidential.

[3] By consent the terms set out in the attached confidential settlement shall become the order of the Authority.

[4] For the purposes of preserving confidentiality, I make a further order, pursuant to clause 10 of the Second Schedule to the [Employment Relations Act](#), prohibiting the publication of the contents of the terms of settlement or the name of the Applicant to that settlement.
