ORDER OF THE AUTHORITY BY CONSENT

Employment Relationship Problem

[1] This morning I convened a meeting with the parties to investigate an employment relationship problem. They advised that they wished me to record their agreement on the form of an order by consent. They also advised that they wished those terms to remain confidential.
