DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

Employment relationship problem

[1] In its determination issued on 11 February 2010 under AA60/10 the Authority ordered Mr Lisati Ta'amilo to pay \$175 to Computer Transport Services (NZ) Limited. That was assessed as a contribution towards the company's expenses incurred in having a witness attend the Authority's meeting held to investigate Mr Ta'amilo's unsuccessful personal grievance claim.

[2] Computer Transport Services (NZ) Limited has applied to the Authority to have the expenses order enforced.

[3] Mr Ta'amilo accepts that he can repay \$175 plus the \$70 filing fee, in instalments as agreed to by Mr Lorimer for the company.

[4] Pursuant to s137 of the Employment Relations Act 2000 the Authority therefore orders payment of \$245 to be made by Mr Ta'amilo to Computer Transport

Services (NZ) Ltd. There will be four payments of \$50 made by the end of each month, starting in June 2010, and a last payment of \$45 by the end of October.
