DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY (No 2)

[1] Christopher Lewis owes Cook Executive Recruitment (2005) Limited (“CERL”) the sum of \$27,666.51 (“the sum owed”). CERL seeks an order that Mr Lewis comply with his obligation to repay that money.

[2] Mr Lewis said he was not in a position to make the repayment. Following a discussion between the Authority and the parties on 24 July 2007 the following arrangement was reached:

- (a) Mr Lewis would pay to CERL the sum of \$15,000 within 7 days, with suitable further orders regarding repayment of the balance of the sum owed to be considered at that time;
- (b) Mr Lewis would file an affidavit of his assets and liabilities by the same date;

(c) Should Mr Lewis default on the payment identified in (a) above, the Authority would issue an order for immediate payment of the sum owed.

[3] Counsel has advised that Mr Lewis has defaulted on payment. Mr Lewis has not filed an affidavit of assets and liabilities.

[4] Mr Lewis is therefore ordered to pay to CERL forthwith the sum of \$27,665.51.

[5] I confirm that the orders made by consent in the determination dated 6 July 2007 remain in force.
