[1] During attendance at a judicial settlement conference held on Friday

21 February 2014, the parties successfully resolved their respective claims and have

requested that the resulting settlement be incorporated in a consent judgment made by the Court.

[2] The parties have agreed to a record of settlement, a copy of which will be held on the Court file in a sealed envelope.

[3] By consent, orders are made as set out in the confidential record of settlement. The terms set out in the record of settlement are full, final and binding in respect of all employment related matters between the parties.

[4] The parties have agreed that the terms of settlement shall remain confidential.

[5] Pursuant to cl 12(2) of Schedule 3 to the [Employment Relations Act 2000](#), a further order is made prohibiting the publication of the contents of the terms of settlement without leave of the Court.

[6] There are no issues as to costs, and the Court's file will now be closed.
