CONSENT JUDGMENT OF JUDGE K G SMITH

[1] This proceeding is a challenge to a determination of the Employment Relations Authority.¹

[2] The parties have reached a full and final settlement of all matters between them and have asked the Court to record their agreement in a judgment.

[3] By consent the following orders are made:

(a) The Authority's determination is set aside and this judgment stands in its place.

(b) The dispute between the parties has been resolved in full pursuant to a settlement agreement which is confidential to the parties and their advisors.

(c) Money presently held by the Registrar of the Court pursuant to an order made on 20 December 2023,² is to be paid to the defendant or at his direction.

(d) The proceeding is discontinued and there is no issue as to costs.
