DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

Employment Relationship Problem

[1] The applicant seeks compliance with a Consent Order AA 76/07 made on 15 March 2007 requiring the respondent to pay the applicant the sum of \$5,228.84 wages and holiday pay and \$70 being the filing fee.

[2] Those amounts have not been paid.

[3] The respondent is to pay the amounts set out in para [1] to the applicant forthwith.

[4] The applicant is also to be paid the \$70 filing fee for this application.

[5] The applicant has sought the payment of interest on the sums owed. The Authority's jurisdiction pursuant to s 138 (4) (a) [Employment Relations Act 2000](#) does not extend to ordering the payment of interest on the payment of moneys which
