### JUDGMENT OF JUDGE K G SMITH

#### (Discharge of freezing order and ancillary order by consent)

[1] On 26 March 2020 a freezing order and an ancillary order were made without notice, relating to the assets of Kyoung Yong Lee.<sup>1</sup>

[2] The orders were to be reviewed at a hearing today. In anticipation of that hearing the parties filed a joint memorandum recording an agreement they have made for funds to be held by a stakeholder pending the outcome of the Authority's investigation. The memorandum requested that the freezing order and ancillary order be discharged because of that agreement. The parties have reached agreement as to costs.
