**DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY**

[1] Upon my issuing a substantive determination in the above matter, dated 15 April 2005, some matters associated with the parties' employment relationship problem remained unresolved. A date had been set for a further investigation meeting, but an adjournment was sought.

[2] The parties representatives have now approached the Authority seeking a consent order in the terms they provided. The order they seek is as follows:

1. That parties agree that costs incurred in relation to determination AA 132/05 will lie where they fall.
2. The applicant will not file or seek a challenge, appeal, review, or de novo rehearing in relation to the Authority's determination AA 132/05 in the Employment Court.

[3] In the sense that the order addresses an agreement the parties have reached, I order accordingly.
