CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

[1] Prior to the conclusion of the Authority's investigation meeting the parties successfully resolved the employment relationship problem between them. The parties have requested the Authority make consent orders in respect of their agreement.

[2] By consent and by this determination the terms of settlement are incorporated into a consent order and are now orders of the Authority.
