

[3] Mr Gelb sought an order for a contribution to costs in the sum of \$3,000 to the total costs of representation of \$10,788.16 incurred by Mr Petersen plus the Authority filing fee of \$71.56.

[4] Mr Boyle in response submitted that as Mr Petersen was only partially successful, costs should be reduced. Mr Boyle sought an order that SB Auto pay a contribution to Mr Petersen's costs of \$1,500.

[5] The Authority's power to award costs arises from Schedule 2, clause 15 of the Employment Relations Act 2000. This confers a wide discretion on the Authority to award costs, on a principled basis. The general principle is that costs follow the event.

[6] The Employment Court in *Carter Holt Harvey v. Eastern Bays Independent Industrial Workers Union & Ors*² observed that a notional daily tariff approach, which was to be adjusted in a principled way, was best suited to the Authority's unique jurisdiction.

[7] Mr Gelb for Mr Petersen seeks an award of \$3,000 which is less than the notional daily rate of \$3,500. Mr Gelb has not provided any reasons as to why the Authority should depart from the notional daily rate of \$3,500.

[8] The investigation meeting took one full day in the Authority and it is appropriate that there should be some contribution by SB Auto towards Mr Petersen's costs to reflect his partial success.

[9] I found Mr Petersen's dismissal for serious misconduct unjustifiable but held that he had contributed to the circumstances giving rise to the grievance. I determined that remedies should be reduced by 50% to take into account Mr Petersen's contribution. My view is that the notional daily rate should be decreased to reflect the fact that Mr Petersen was partially successful due to his contribution.

[10] I conclude that the notional daily rate should be decreased to \$1,500 plus disbursements of \$71.56.

[11] SB Auto is therefore ordered to contribute to Mr Petersen's costs in the sum of \$1,500 plus \$71.56 filing fee.
