JUDGMENT OF JUDGE M E PERKINS

[1] By consent, the plaintiff's challenge has been discontinued on terms contained in a confidential settlement agreement reached between the parties. The memorandum containing the terms of settlement is to be held on the Court file in a sealed envelope and is not to be inspected by any person without leave of a Judge.
