CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

[1] In a substantive determination issued on 5 October 2017¹ the Authority determined that the applicant, Ms Prakash, had not been unjustifiably dismissed. The investigation meeting took 2 full days and a further 90 minutes on a third day. Costs were reserved and the parties were invited to exchange memoranda as to costs.

[2] Accordingly, the parties filed memoranda as to costs. The respondent seeks costs of \$6,075. The applicant agrees to pay these costs.

[3] The costs sought by the respondent are less than the Authority's daily tariff of

\$4,500 for the first day of an investigation meeting and \$3,500 for each day thereafter.

[4] The parties have asked the Authority to issue a consent determination that the applicant will pay the respondent costs in the sum of \$6,075 within 14 days of the date of this determination.

[5] Accordingly, I order the applicant to pay the respondent the sum of \$6,075 as a contribution towards its costs, within 14 days of the date of this determination.

[6] This consent order is final, binding and enforceable.
