



terms of settlement of the interim matter be incorporated into an order of the Authority by consent.

[5] I therefore record the terms of the settlement as follows:

1. The first respondent undertakes to be bound in all respects with provisions of clauses 38 and 48 of the Policy and Procedure Manual/House Rules attached as Exhibit A to the affidavit of Gerald Leslie Hudson sworn on 18 June 2008.
2. The second respondent undertakes not to incite, instigate, aid or abet any breach of the provisions of clauses 38 and 48 of the Police and Procedure Manual/House Rules attached as Exhibit A to the affidavit of Gerald Leslie Hudson sworn on 18 June 2008.
3. Such undertakings are without prejudice to any parties rights to argue substantive issues before the Employment Relations Authority or the Employment Court.
4. The parties agree that costs shall be reserved to the substantive hearing.

[6] The terms set out in the settlement are also the orders of the Authority in this matter.
