<b>CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY</b>		

[1] At the start of the investigation meeting on 20 November 2018 the parties wished to pursue settlement discussions. They later advised the Authority that they had reached a settlement of all issues between them.

[2] The terms and conditions of their agreed settlement are recorded in a confidential settlement agreement (“the Settlement”). The settlement was been signed by both parties on 20 November 2018.

[3] The parties have asked the Authority to issue a:

- a. consent determination recording the terms of the Settlement;
- b. a non-publication order to preserve the confidentiality of the parties and the Settlement.

[4] By consent the terms of the Settlement signed by the parties become consent orders of the Authority. These consent orders are final, binding and enforceable.

[5] The original terms of the Settlement agreed by the parties are therefore not attached to this determination but will instead be held on the Authority’s file. Each party has been provided with a copy of the Settlement for their reference.

[6] For the purposes of preserving confidentiality I order, pursuant clause 10 of Schedule Two of the [Employment Relations Act 2000](#), that the identities of the parties and the agreed terms of the Settlement shall not be published.

[7] The non-publication order issued by the Authority in its Notice of Direction of 16 November 2018 regarding the witness whom I now call Witness S, regarding the name and any identifying details of Witness S, shall continue.
