PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

A. A non-publication order applies to the confidential information regarding investors within the Global Contrarian Fund Limited and the confidential company correspondence and emails lodged by the applicants in support of their claims.

Employment relationship problem

[1] Mr Rathod and Mr Gulati worked for Fat Prophets Ltd and claim (among other matters) they are owed outstanding commission payments. Fat Prophets has asked the Authority to issue non-publication orders in respect to confidential information regarding investors within the Global Contrarian Fund Limited and confidential company correspondence and emails lodged in the Authority in support of their claims.

[2] The applicants do not oppose the application and during a case management call on 5 October I advised the parties that a non-publication order will be made. This determination confirms the order.

[3] I am satisfied there is no public interest in having confidential information made publicly available.

[4] I am satisfied it is in the interests of justice to issue non-publication orders in respect of the confidential information regarding investors within the Global Contrarian Fund Limited and the confidential company correspondence and emails

lodged by the applicants in support of their claims.

[5] Accordingly, pursuant to clause 10 of the Second Schedule of the [Employment Relations Act 2000](#) the Authority orders that a non-publication order applies to the confidential information regarding investors within the Global Contrarian Fund Limited and the confidential company correspondence and emails lodged by the applicants in support of their claims.
