### CONSENT JUDGMENT OF CHIEF JUDGE CHRISTINA INGLIS

[1] These proceedings involve a challenge to a substantive determination of the Employment Relations Authority dated 11 March 2022<sup>1</sup> and a subsequent costs determination.<sup>2</sup>
