INTERLOCUTORY JUDGMENT (NO 2) OF CHIEF JUDGE CHRISTINA INGLIS

(Application for continuation of freezing order)

[1] On 14 April 2022 I granted an application for freezing and ancillary orders against Mr Munro, a former employee of Solander Maritime Ltd.<sup>1</sup> A subsequent application to continue the freezing order was granted on 29 April 2022.<sup>2</sup> The freezing order was to have effect until 27 May 2022, unless on that date it was continued or renewed.
