DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

Enforcement and Compliance

[1] There has been no appearance by the Respondent. There has been no good cause for the non appearance. I am satisfied that the Respondent was served with the statement of problem and application for enforcement of a signed off settlement. Also I am satisfied that the Respondent was served with the notice for the investigation meeting. The Authority's support officer tried to make contact with the Respondent by telephone without any success. There has been no statement in reply filed in the Authority. I decided to proceed in the Respondent's absence pursuant to clause 12 of Schedule 2 of the [Employment Relations Act](#) and to act as fully in the matter as if the Respondent had duly attended or been represented.

[2] The applicant has applied for the enforcement of a settlement between the parties. The parties signed off a settlement and the settlement was recorded and signed off by a mediator from the Department of Labour. The existence of the Record of Settlement is not disputed. An agreed sum of money was not fully paid by the Respondent and attempts were made to obtain the outstanding payments without any success.

[3] I have decided to resolve the matter as requested by the Applicant for the payment in full. Evolution Paving and Landscaping Ltd is to pay to Matthew Turley the sum of \$1,200. This sum is
