CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS AUTHORITY

Employment relationship problem

[1] At today's investigation meeting the parties advised the Authority that they had reached a settlement of all issues between. The terms and conditions of this settlement are recorded in a confidential Terms of Settlement agreement which was signed by both parties today ("the Settlement").

[2] By consent the specific terms recorded in the Settlement which were agreed to and signed by the parties today now become consent orders of the Authority and as such are final binding and enforceable.
