CONSENT DETERMINATION OF AUTHORITY: Costs

Employment Relationship Problem

1. In my determination WA 151/05 dated 13 September 2005 I found against Ms Tania Wright's claim that she had been unjustifiably dismissed by the Company during her absence from work on parental. Costs were reserved.
2. By way of email received on 5 October the parties advised the Authority of their agreement that Ms Wright will pay costs of \$1,500.00 (fifteen hundred dollars) to the

Company by way of two instalments of \$750.00 (seven hundred and fifty dollars), the first by 31 October and the second by 30 November 2005.

3. The parties ask that the agreement be recorded by way of a consent determination. I have no difficulty in accepting that request and hereby issue a consent order determination consistent with the terms of the costs agreement reached by the parties to this employment relationship problem as set out in par. 2 above.
4. The parties are to be commended for the way in which they have settled this matter.
