

ORDER

[5] I order that the names of the parties in the application before the Authority, any information which may lead to the identification of the parties, and the claims of allegedly inappropriate behaviour by the employees of the Respondent are all subject to an interim non-publication order pending the determination of the application for a permanent non-publication order.

[6] The parties are advised that a breach of this Order will be considered as obstructing the Authority's investigation and liable to a penalty pursuant to s134A of the Employment Relations Act 2000 (the Act). Pursuant to s 135(2) of the Act:

(2) Every person who is liable to a penalty under this Act is liable, -

(a) in the case of an individual to a penalty not exceeding \$10,000;

(b) in the case of a company or other corporation, to a penalty not exceeding \$20,000
